

THE NOMADS 100 CLUB RULES

Gambling Commission Rules

Under the Gambling Act there is no specific legal definition for 100 Clubs as they exist to promote lotteries for a 'good cause' (lotteries cannot be run for private or commercial gain). The Nomads 100 Club is a Small Society Lottery and therefore complies with these rules. We do not need a licence from the Gambling Commission, however we do register this club with the Local Licensing Authority.

Purpose

The purpose of our lottery is to raise funds for the Society/Charity and its building. It is run by a 100 Club Secretary who reports in the Fund Raising Committee who in turn report into the Nomads Trustees. The money will be paid into the 100 Club bank account which is not used for any other purpose and used to meet funding requests from the Society/Charity, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for members.

Rules

1. For a cost of £12 per number per year you will be allocated one number between 1 and 200.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total at least 50% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of £30, 2nd prize of £25 and 3rd prize of £20 for each of the 12 months.
5. In the event of the prize money not reaching its 50% target then annual special draws will take place.
6. The 100 Club is a Small Society Lottery and is open to all members, parents, patrons, staff and friends of Nomads. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
7. Numbers are limited to two per person.
8. Payments must be made annually by cheque or electronic bank transfer by the 31st March. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
9. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
10. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
11. The draw shall be made by the 100 Club Secretary once a month in front of a witness.
12. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within 30 days of the draw.
13. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the Members newsletter and on the Nomads website and in our each of our show programmes.
14. The 100 Club will be run by the Finance Sub-Committee. In the event of a dispute, the 100 Club Secretary will escalate to the Nomads Trustees (Nomads Board of Directors). The decision of the Trustees is final.
15. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
16. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed back into 100 Club funds after six months.
